VINDOLANDA.

One of the most exciting archaeological sites in Europe. Live excavations April—September. ROMAN ARMY MUSEUM

HOUSESTEADS ROMAN FORT

Most spectacularly located of all the Hadrian's wall forts. Stunning views, explore natural wilderness and become immersed in the history. Walk alongside the wall to Milecastle 37 and Sycamore Gap—famous as the location for much of the filming of "Robin Hood Price of Thieves"-

An English Heritage and National Trust Site.



LANERCOST PRIORY

Evocative site. No Roman Wall here as the stone was robbed for the building of the Priory! Early example of recycling in a pre-heritage conscious era! Look for the Centrurial Stone—clearly visible, but incorporated into the stonework upside down! Plenty of archeology here, but part of the Priory still functions as the parish church—as, indeed it has been for 850 years. King Edward I ruled from here for six months in the winter 1306 -07. Excellent restaurant and gift shop. English Heritage site
